

# Troop 46 Leadership Position Description

## **DEN CHIEF**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

Type: Appointed by the Scoutmaster  
Term: 1 year  
Reports to: Scoutmaster and Den Leader  
Description: The Den Chief works with the Cub Scouts, Webelos Scouts and Den Leaders in a Cub Scout Pack.  
Comments: The Den Chief provides knowledge of games and scout skills that many Den Leaders lack. The Den Chief is also a recruiter for the troop. This function is important because no troop can thrive without new members and most new members will come from Cub Scouting.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

Age: none  
Rank: Tenderfoot or higher  
Experience: 1 year in Troop  
Attendance: 85% over previous 6 months

### **PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS**

Training: You must attend the troop Junior Leader Training even if you have attended in the past  
Attendance: You are expected to attend all troop meetings, Patrol Leader's Council meetings, outings and service projects. If your attendance is low, you can be removed from office. In terms of attendance with you den, you are expected to attend all den meetings and pack functions. You must inform the Den Leader if you will be absent  
Effort: You are expected to give this job your best effort

### **GENERAL LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES**

Uniform: Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform with all required badges in their correct locations.  
Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.  
Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on time for meetings and activities. You must call the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that someone will assume your responsibilities
